HANDLING SEED OF EUCALYPTUS MAIDENII

(MAIDEN'S GUM)

Seed Issue Note No. (37) 1996

Temporary storage

Seeds should be kept in cool and dry place. Where such conditions are not available, seeds can be kept at ordinary air temperature but out of direct sunshine. Seeds should be sown within one year after collection weeks after collection.

Treatment before sowing

The seed does need any pre-treatment.

Sowing

About 400 g of seeds should be spread 1 m² of seedbed. This will give a space of about 0.5 cm between viable seeds. Seeds should be covered with a thin (1 mm thick) layer of fine sand.

Germination

One kg contains 300,000 (un cleaned) seeds and may produce 100,000 seedlings i.e. 100 seedlings per gram. Transplanting into pots should take place after 7 - 14 days from sowing.
